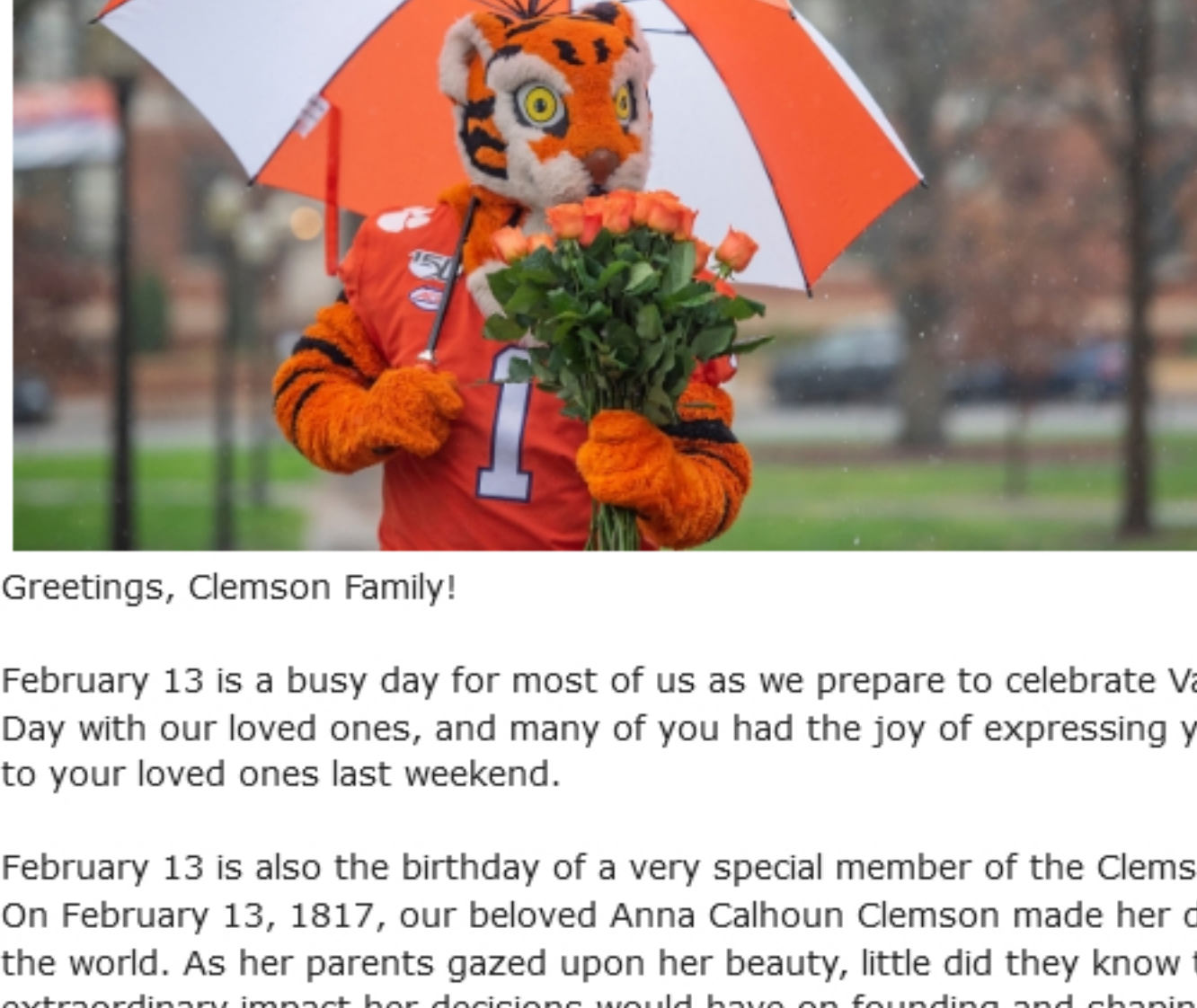

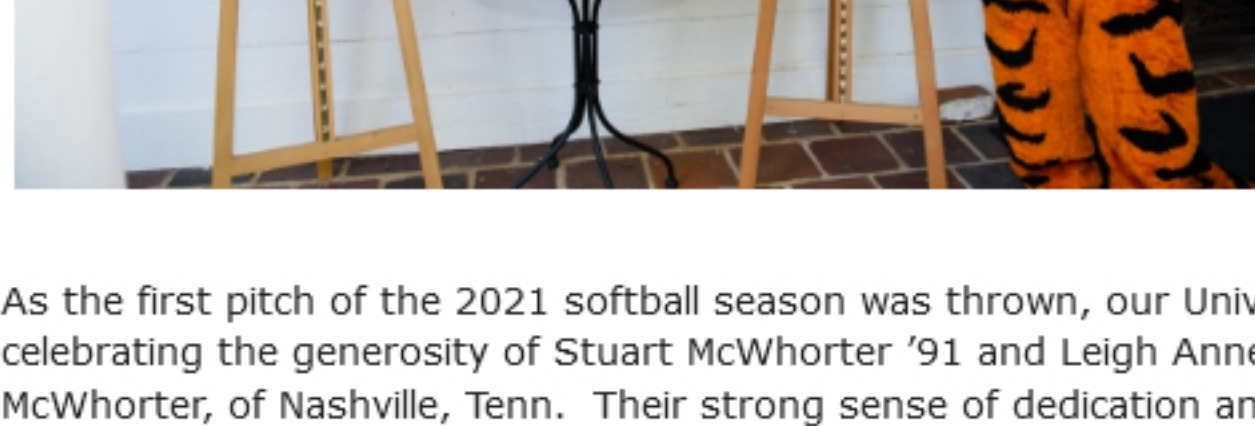


Greetings, Clemson Family!

As her parents gazed upon her beauty, little did they know the vast and extraordinary impact her decisions would have on founding and shaping what is now Clemson University. Anna's beauty, intellect and engaging personality captured the heart of Thomas Green Clemson, which brought him to South Carolina. They wed in the parlor of the Fort Hill mansion and solidified their lifelong partnership to make a difference in the world around them. You may not know that Anna inherited the home and the land adjoining Fort Hill from her parents. She specifically directed Thomas to use the land to carry out their vision for a "higher seminary of learning." The unwavering love that they shared for one another and the love they extended to all of us who have grown to cherish this amazing institution is priceless. Our heritage is indeed rich and full of love. Every time someone becomes a member of the Clemson Family, we share a unique bond that enriches our connection to each other and positions us to enhance the Clemson experience for future generations.
